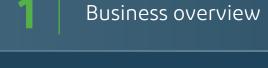

2024 Highlights: Another year of resilient growth and expansion





Significant overall growth, passing 1 million patients served, recording SAR 1.2 billion in revenue (+22.8%), delivering EBITDA of SAR 270 million (+37.8%) and resilient net profit of SAR 94.4 million



Fueled by strong growth in acute care services, with clinics spanning ENT, ophthalmology, dermatology, plastic surgery, IVF, neurology, rheumatology, oncology, general surgery, urology, primary care, and home healthcare achieving significant expansion



Successful launch of Rehabilitation Hospital, with bed occupancy exceeding 50% and reaching EBITDA break-even. Facility introduces comprehensive long-term care and rehabilitation services catering to adult and pediatric patients. Almoosa is the first healthcare provider to offer mental health services in the Eastern Province



Almoosa Health continues to advance its expansion strategy with the development of two major hospitals projects aimed at enhancing specialized acute care services and increasing patient access across key regions, as well as new medical centers, demonstrating our commitment to expanding and enhancing integrated healthcare network



Expanded residency and fellowship programs with 15 residency programs, 7 fellowship programs, and 2 diploma programs. By the end of 2024, 108 physicians were enrolled

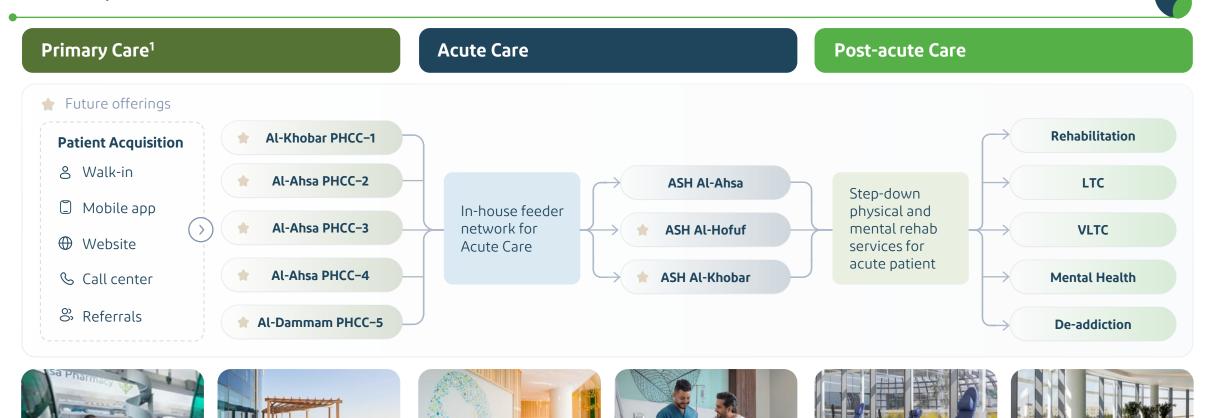

4Q-2025

Nakheel Primary Healthcare Center Al-Ahsa



Current Status: The location has been identified, and architectural work is complete. We are provisioning 30-40 clinics, along with a lab, radiology center, and pharmacy. The project is progressing steadily, with notable advancements in staffing preparations and procurement processes

2Q-2027

Sulmaniyah Primary Healthcare Center Al-Ahsa



Current Status: Located in Hofuf, the architectural work is complete, and we are provisioning 40-50 clinics. The center is also equipped with advanced diagnostic and imaging facilities, infusion therapy, drive-through pharmacy, and community-oriented spaces, ensuring a holistic and patient-centered approach to care delivery

3Q-2025

Aziziya Primary Healthcare Center Al-Khobar



Current Status: The location has been identified, the architectural work is complete, and we are provisioning 40 clinics. The center also hosts a Rehabilitation Satellite, Infusion Center, Radiology, Pharmacy, Laboratory, Community Hub, Physiotherapy, and Prosthetic. The project is in advance stage, with substantive progress achieved to open the center in Q3 2025

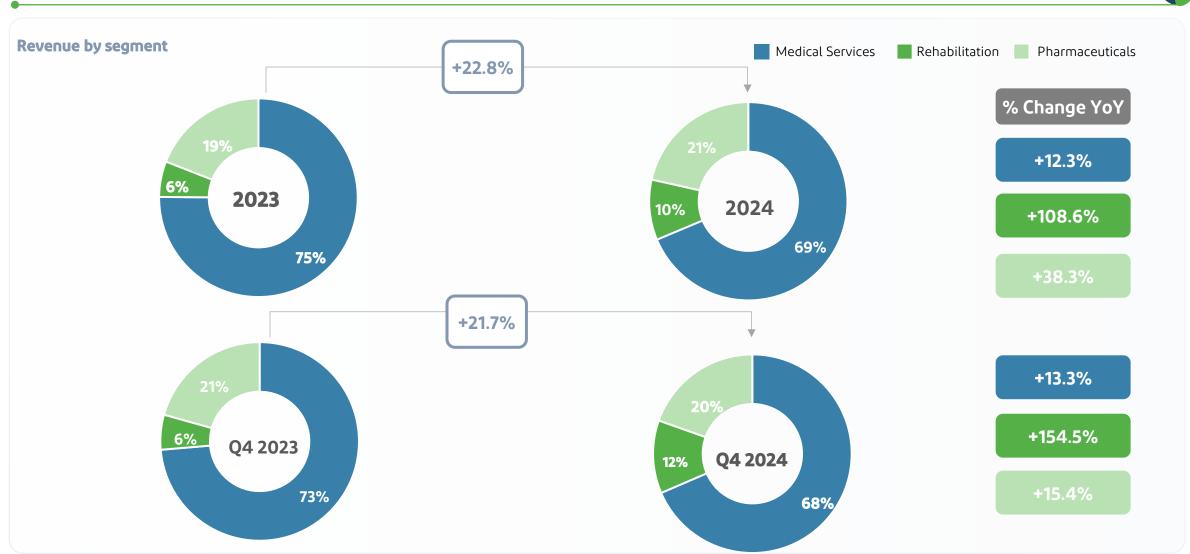

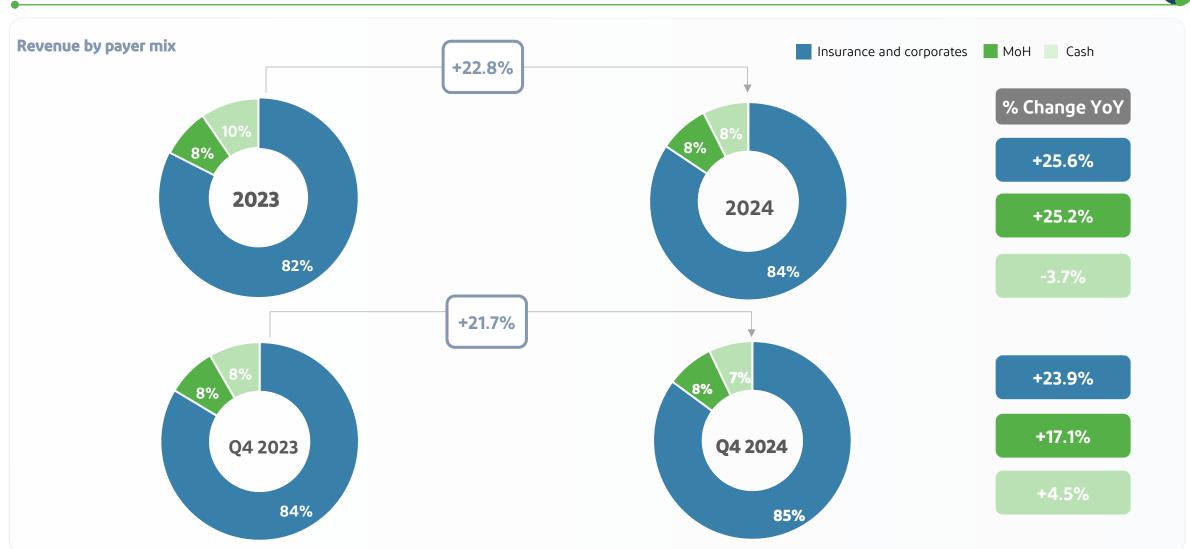
All segments contributing to strong growth

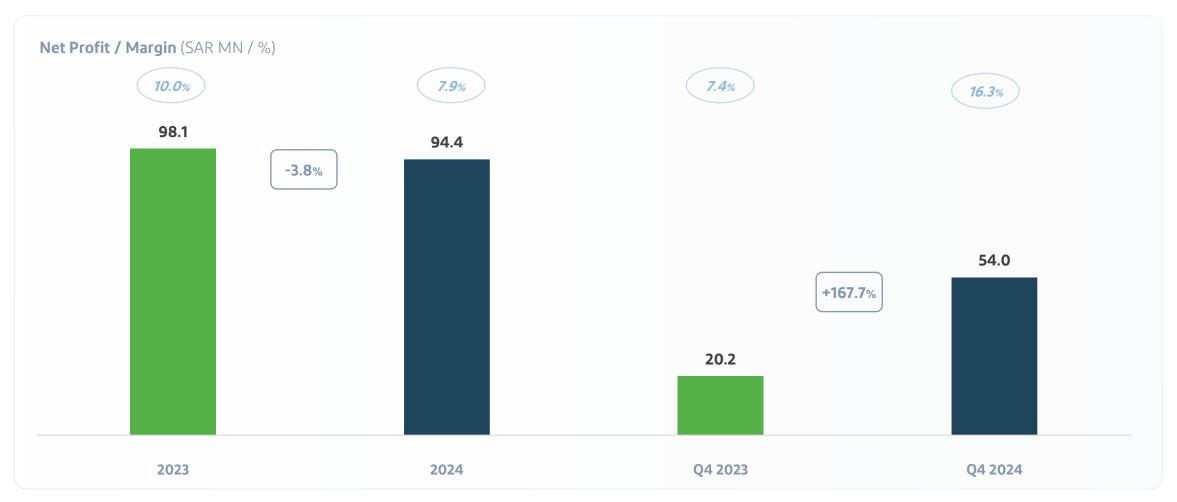

Resilient net profit amid new hospital opening and service expansion





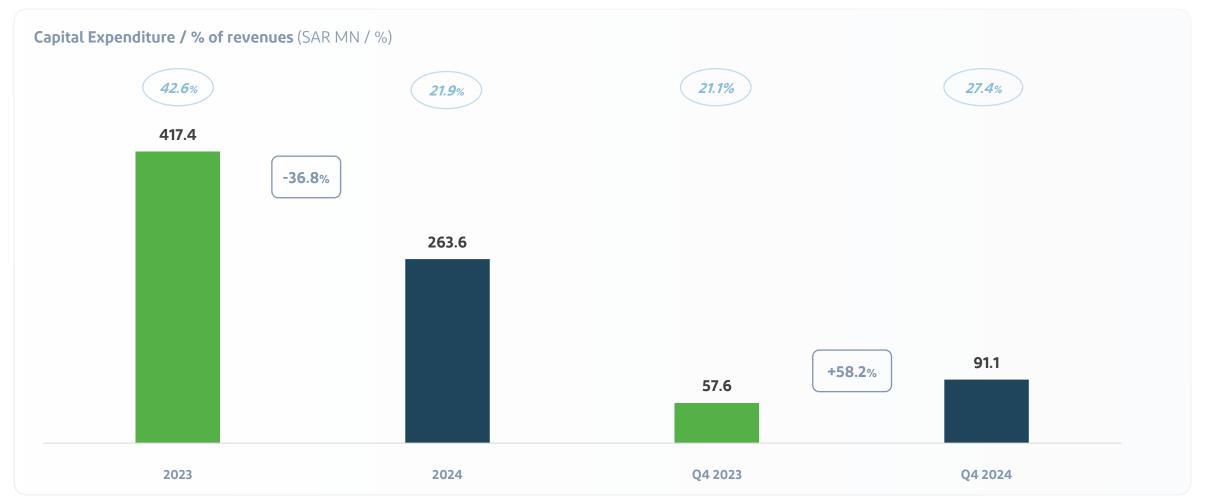

Summary and strategic priorities



2024 Milestones

Significant increase in patient volume, driven by ramp up in Rehabilitation Hospital combined with an expanded specialty mix

Strong financial performance underpinned by 22.8% growth in Revenue and 37.8% in EBITDA

Attracted overwhelming demand from investors as the second-largest Saudi IPO of 2024, **103x oversubscribed**



2025 Strategic Priorities

- Integrating services across primary care, acute care, rehabilitation, and long-term care. This seamless coordination will provide patients with comprehensive, continuous care tailored to their needs, reducing fragmentation and improving overall health outcomes
- Expanding rehabilitation services by incorporating advanced therapies and patient-centered programs
- Expanding primary care services to improve early diagnosis and management of health conditions, leading to better patient outcomes
- Focusing on medical tourism to diversify revenue streams and strengthen the Company's global reputation

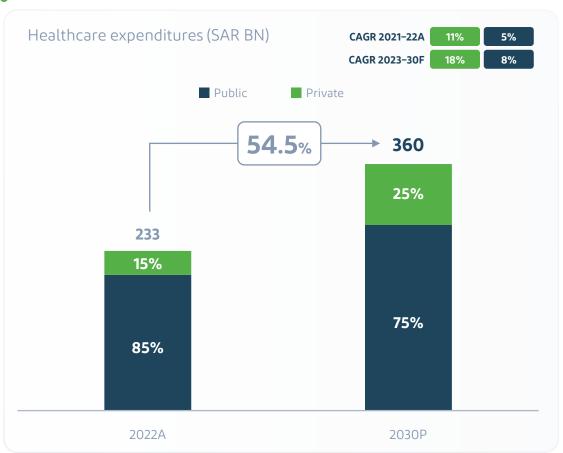

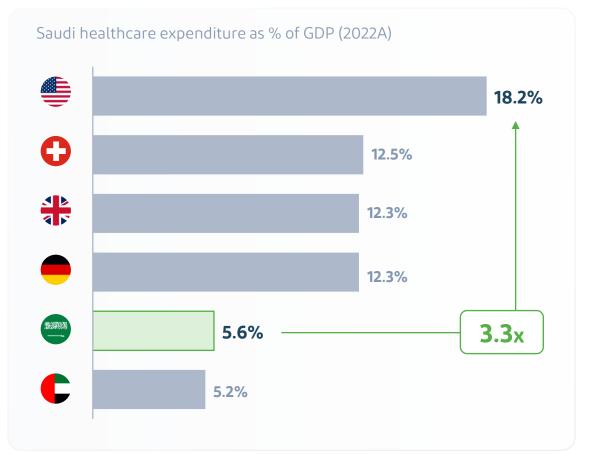
